Welcome Class of 2016 Peak Performance Program for Aspiring Leaders!



The Atlanta Federal Executive Board (FEB) has launched its 2016 Peak Performance Program (P3). This program was established in 2013 to target full-time federal employees grades GS/7 to GS/12 in order to offer opportunities for development and leadership training for aspiring leaders.

The P3 program consists of 12 classes which are scheduled throughout the calendar year and delivered in three semesters beginning February and continues through September. These classes concentrate on developing aspiring leaders by evolving their oral communication,

written communication, public service, self-direction, problem solving, and decision making, along with many other leadership competencies vital for effective leadership.

The class of 2016 consists of 37 students, who have dedicated themselves to the eight classes offered along with the enforced class punctuality and attendance requirements the FEB has implemented. The P3 students are selected by a panel of individuals from various federal agencies who scored them on their written responses to five
